History

Founded in 1976 by a group of orthopedic surgeons, Novant Health Charlotte Orthopedic Hospital is the region's only orthopedic hospital, providing a full range of services for orthopedic injuries and conditions. In 2018, Novant Health completed a major renovation and expansion project for Charlotte Orthopedic Hospital, which included seven state-of-the-art inpatient operating rooms and one procedural room, as well as an outpatient surgery center with five additional operating rooms and two procedure rooms. This facility was designed to integrate the entire patient experience from a pre-operative surgical wellness clinic to operating rooms equipped with robotic and artificial intelligence technologies, to inpatient acute care and physical therapy services to help patients recover after their surgery.
