History

Novant Health Forsyth Medical Center was founded in 1887 as a 10-bed hospital inside a private home. Episcopal minister Henry O. Lacy worked with the Ladies Twin City Association and other volunteers to raise money for the hospital to address the community’s growing need for healthcare. The Twin City Hospital existed in several different locations until 1959 when voters approved purchase of a 77-acre campus that is Novant Health Forsyth Medical Center’s current home. In 2019, Forsyth Medical Center broke ground on a multiphase, \$400 million expansion which includes a new five-story, 193,480-square-foot tower with 60 critical care and 36 patient rooms. The project is scheduled for completion in 2024. To make weight-loss surgery more accessible for patients in the Triad, Novant Health Forsyth Medical Center began offering bariatric surgery on November 1, 2022.
