History

Novant Health Kernersville Medical Center opened in 2011, providing an option for patients who previously had to travel to Greensboro or Winston-Salem for healthcare. A newly constructed medical office building opened in 2013, bringing cancer treatment services to the area, as well as additional specialty physician practices. In 2017, a second medical office building was added to Kernersville Medical Center. In 2018, an ambulatory surgery center opened in the second medical office building. In 2021, Kernersville Medical Center broke ground for its new 60,000 square-foot expansion, which will include the construction of a new fourth-floor birthing center. This will be the first time maternity care services have been offered at Kernersville Medical Center, which will provide a more convenient labor and delivery care option for expecting mothers in eastern Forsyth and western Guilford communities. The \$55 million expansion project will also include the addition of medical beds, an expanded intensive care unit and the installation of a new heart and vascular lab.
