History

Sixty years ago, a group of women saw a need for a hospital in Culpeper and raised the money needed to open Culpeper Memorial Hospital. Building on their mission to provide quality, convenient care, the medical center continued to grow to meet the changing needs of its community. Culpeper Hospital affiliated with the University of Virginia Health System in 2009. In 2016, Novant Health’s Virginia operations, including Novant Health Haymarket Medical Center, Novant Health Prince William Medical Center, Novant Health Cancer Center, Novant Health Caton Merchant House and the Novant Health physician clinics, joined UVA Culpeper Hospital to form Novant Health UVA Health System. Today, the facility is known as Novant Health UVA Health System Culpeper Medical Center.
