Specimen Container:		Sterile screw-cap container Syringe with needle removed prior to bringing to the laboratory.
Minimum Volume Required:		0.5 mL
Testing Availability	Routine: Stat:	24 hours/day No
Turnaround Time:		Preliminary reports for aerobic organisms are reported after 24 hours. Anaerobic organisms can be reported after 48 hours. Complete reports including both aerobes and anaerobes may take as long as 10 days after receipt of culture.
Special Handling:		Specimens must be delivered to the laboratory within 30 minutes of collection.
