Clinical Significance:	Lithium ions in the brain produce gradual control of acute episodes of mania in patients with manic-depressive affective disorders.
Reference Range:	0.6 – 1.2 mmol/L
Critical Value:	> 1.2 mmol/L

Minimum Volume:	2 mL whole blood 500 uL whole blood from microtainer
Special Handling:	Specimens usually drawn 12 hours after last dose of lithium
