Causes for Specimen Rejection:		Improper labeling Clotted specimen Hemolysis Specimen diluted with IV fluid or contaminated with heparin Specimens that are too old Tubes must be fille to top of blue line on label
Clinical Significance:		Screening test for deficiencies of plasma coagulation factors other than factors vii and xiii. The test is also used to monitor patients on heparin therapy.
